JUNE 2016

Environment Day Observation on 5th June 2016

The NSS Unit of Little flower college Guruvayoor is blessed with a group of energetic and vibrant, hardworking, dedicated volunteers. The NSS activities of this academic year were launched with the world environment day observation. On 4th June 2016 NSS team with the Programme Officer visited Prof. Santhakumari, Chairperson of Guruvayoor Municipality and Councilor of our adopted areas (Ward No:16 of Guruvayoor Municipality) and made necessary arrangement for the observation of Environmental Day in association with the 'HARITHASREE PROJECT' initiated by Kerala Govt.
