

- SUO Manju M.M attended the NIC held at Kanjangad during 2018Dec 22nd to 2019 Jan 2nd.




 Our NCC contingent participated in the Republic Day rally held at Guruvayoor Municipality with high spirit and secured first place in parade competition on 26 January 2019.
