REPORT OF NCC ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR 2016-17



- Stemy Mariya attended the **National Integration Camp** at Calicut from 1/12/2016 12/12/2016




• SUO Aiswarya A.G and UO Anju V Jammu attended the **National integration camp** at Rourkela during December 6th to 17th 2016.
