- Clashes b/w moderates and extremists in the congress ended in the spliting of the party
- Clash broke out in the Congress session of 1906 for presidencial eleection of congress – contaversy was resolved with the election of Dadabhai Naoroji
- next session of Congress changed from Nagpur to Surat, which was prefered place for moderates.
- The moderates attempt to avoid Tilak and replace him with Rash Bihari Bose as the President
- Congress meeting from 26th December- 2nd day clashes- Rash Bihar Bose speak- Tilak ran up to the presidential platformphysical confrontation b/w two groups

- Slippers, chairs and lathis were thrown
- Congress split- moderates captured the party
- Split far reaching consequences- weakended the national movt.- British use split to destroy the national movt
- In 1916 the two wings of Congress were united in Lucknow Session and the Congress regained its lost strength
