#### The Great Fire of London-1666

- It was a disaster- caused great damage- unparalled in the history of England-
- Samuel Pepys detailed account given
- It raged for five days and burnt up half of London-The heart of the city from Tower to Fleet Street(place of Printing newspaper)was consumed by the fire.
- Old St. Paul's and other 88 churches were destroyed. The wretched slums were not touched by fire-Both the govt. people nothing do in time to arrest its progress. Disaster was a blessing in disguisedestroyed the old wooden structures- get golden chance for ChristopherWren to rebuild the city in brick & stone- St. Pauls still bear testimony for the skill of master builder.
