Anatomy of Ear

- <u>The outer Ear:</u> It includes Pinna , auditory canal upto the the eardrum
- <u>The middle ear:</u> filed with air. Three tiny bones. They are malleus, incus and stapes
- Malleus is the connection to the eardrum whereas the stapes is attached to the inner ear's oval window.
- <u>The inner ear :</u> extends till auditory nerve.
