Anatomy of Ear

- The outer Ear: It includes Pinna , auditory canal upto the the eardrum
- The middle ear: filed with air. Three tiny bones. They are malleus, incus and stapes
- Malleus is the connection to the eardrum whereas the stapes is attached to the inner ear's oval window.
- The inner ear : extends till auditory nerve.
