
READING WEEK CELEBRATIONS

was attended by the graduate and Post-Graduate students. The workshop was very useful for the students. It gave them an insight to carry on their research.




PAINTING COMPETITION IN CONNECTION WITH WORLD TOURISM DAY ON 27/09/2022


National Seminar on
