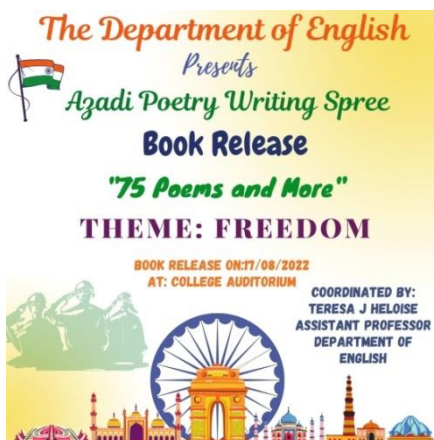


Manuscript Magazine – 75 freedom poems and more. Azadi Poetry Writing Spree-15th, 16th and 17th August 2022
