AIM

With the aim of nurturing the entrepreneurial skills of the students the Department of Economics started the ventures Unnathi& Earn a Living.Unnathi aims at giving hand- embroidery training to women whereas Earn a Living Programme promotes any activity that will help women to be self-sufficient.

UNNATHI

This Hand Embroidery Training Wing was inaugurated on 19th June 2019 by Prof. SanthaKumari, 16th Ward Councillor, Guruvayoor Municipality. A group of students of our Department acquired skill by themselves and trained the mothers and women folk of Moopen colony as a means of earn a living .This programme aims to develop self sufficiency among women and enable them to spend their leisure time fruitfully. For this purpose our students arranged practical classes and also provided materials. The students even planned to sell the clothes. Every Thursday during the activity hour in the afternoon session our students used to visit Moopen Colony and train the women of the Colony.

EARN A LIVING PROGRAMME

As a part of the programme for empowering themselves to earn a living, our students planned to conduct an office file making workshop for fellow students. They learned to make files by doing and also trained their fellow-mates. They formed a group of ten members and made around 200 files, paper pen and note pad .They arranged a sale day on 9.10.2018 in the college premises and earned Rs.2000/- that day itself. Sales of files were done at the request from various departments.
