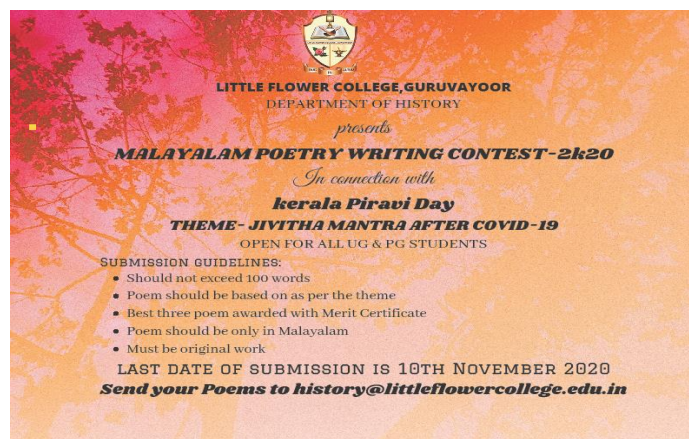
POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

BRIDGE COURSE FROM 10TH NOVEMBER 2020 TO 13TH NOVEMBER 2020

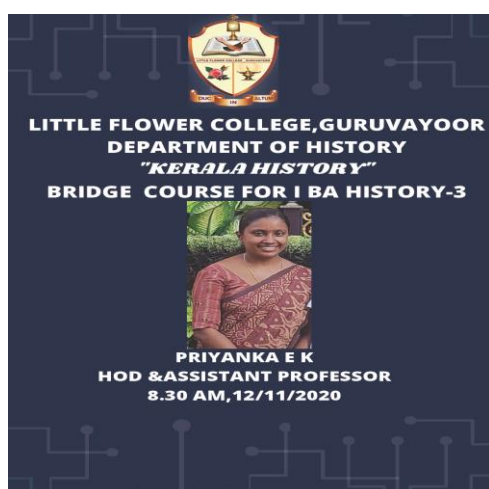
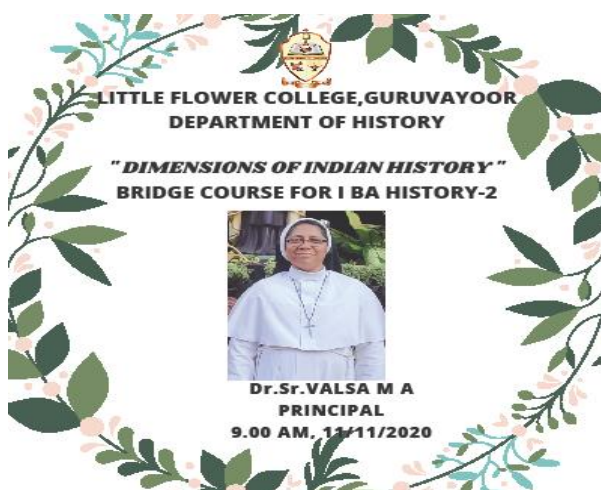

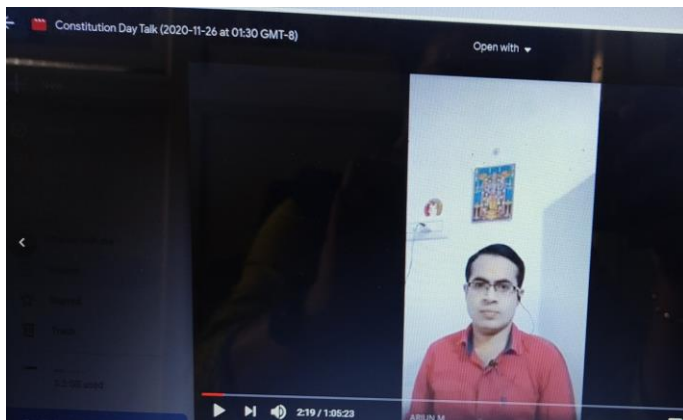

A TALK ON CONSTITUTIONAL PERSPECTIVE OF THE POSITION OF PRESIDENT OF INDIA

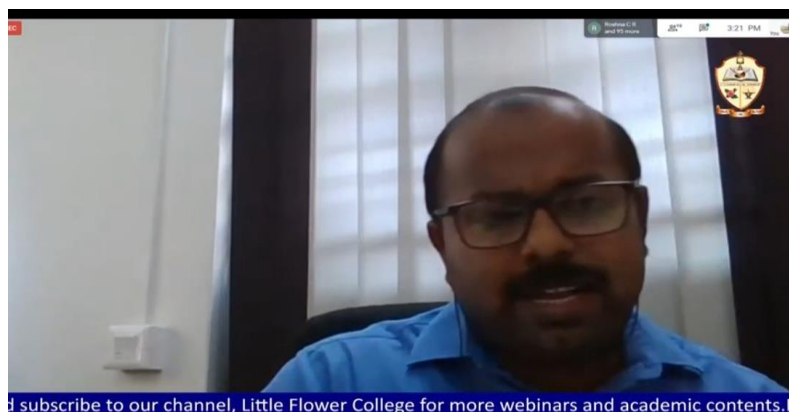
