The Scholar Support Programme, a part of the new initiatives in the higher education initiated by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Kerala aims at imparting additional support to the students in the weak areas of their curriculum. Envisioning these goals of the government, the college runs the Scholar Support Programme in five subjects, English, Economics, Mathematics, Computer Science and Physics.

Ten students from each of the above mentioned subjects, in first year, second and final year U.G programme were selected on merit basis, after the first meeting of the Coordinator, with the mentors. And the classes were scheduled to the activity hour (1-2pm) on every Fridays. On the very first day of the mentoring sessions, the scholars were provided with writing aids like notebook and pen. Those deserving students were provided with the study aid too.

Many teachers, considering the pulse of students opened up 'Whats App' groups and posted study materials on the subject, guidance in both curricular and personal mentoring were also given. The mentors also conducted daily quiz to ensure the students' interest in the subject of study and the scholars gave a very high response to this on-line mentoring.

Both the coordinator and the mentors were given ample training programmes. It is very significant to state here, about the full attendance of the faculty members of SSP in this college, at the Mentors' training programme conducted at Vimala College Thrissur.
