9. MALAYALAM POETRY WRITING CONTEST-2K20”

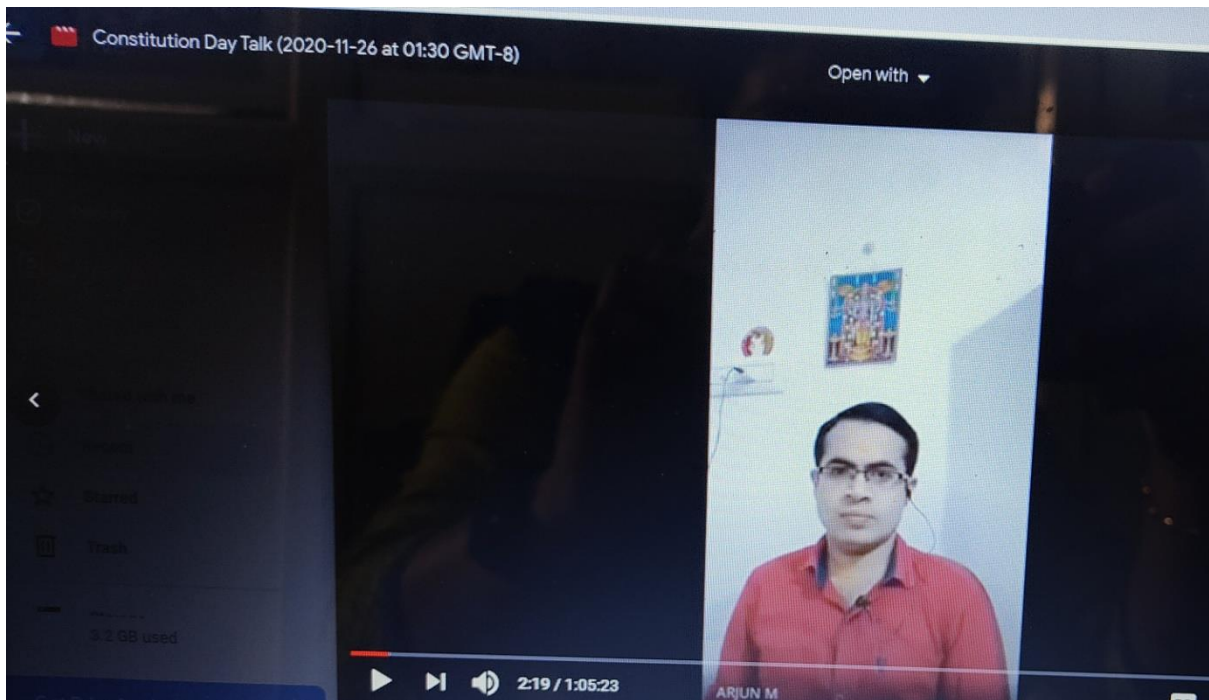
