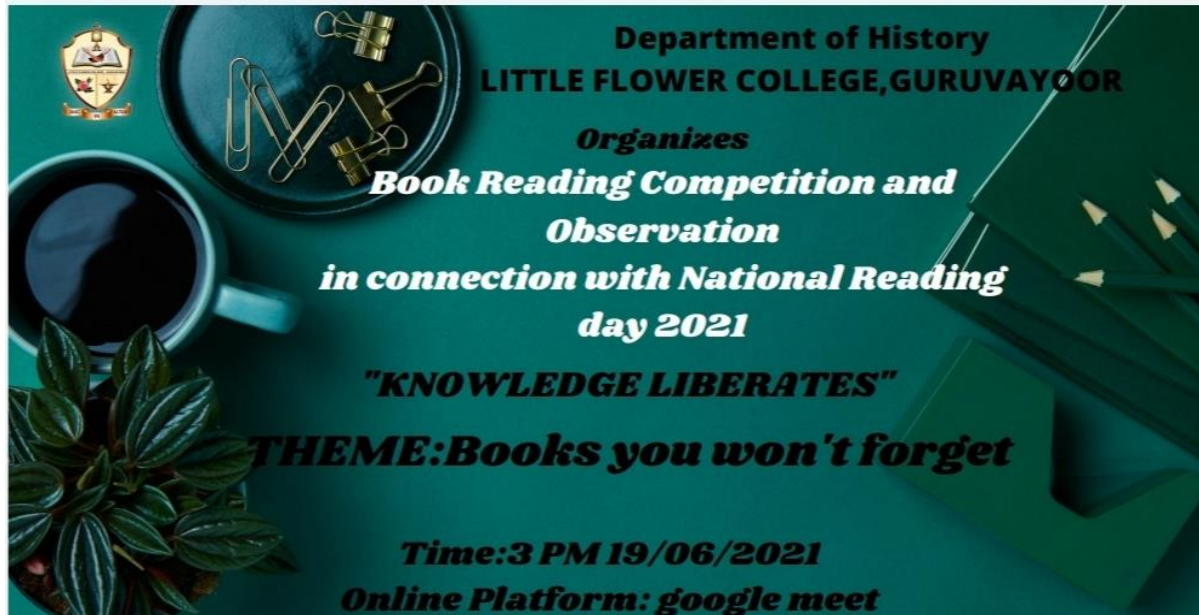

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## ONLINE BOOK READING COMPETITION

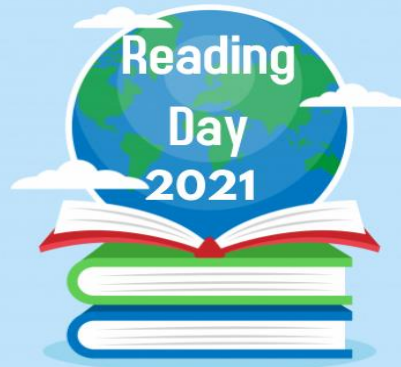

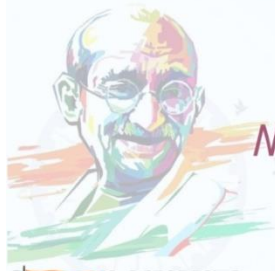
**IN CONNECTION WITH QUIT INDIA MOVEMENT DAY**

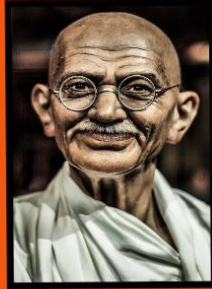
### **ESSAY WRITING CONTEST IN CONNECTION WITH GANDHI JAYANTHI**
