## **ECONOMICA – INAUGURATION OF ASSOCIATION**







TWO -DAY ECONOMIC FEST- ARTHULLAS 2023

#### UNION BUDGET 2023-24:IS IT A BOON OR BANE? :ARTHVAAD






## ECONOMIC EXPO AND QUIZ HUT ON INDIAN ECONOMY: PROSPECTS AND CHALLEGES


