


DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS ACTIVITY REPORT 2023-2024

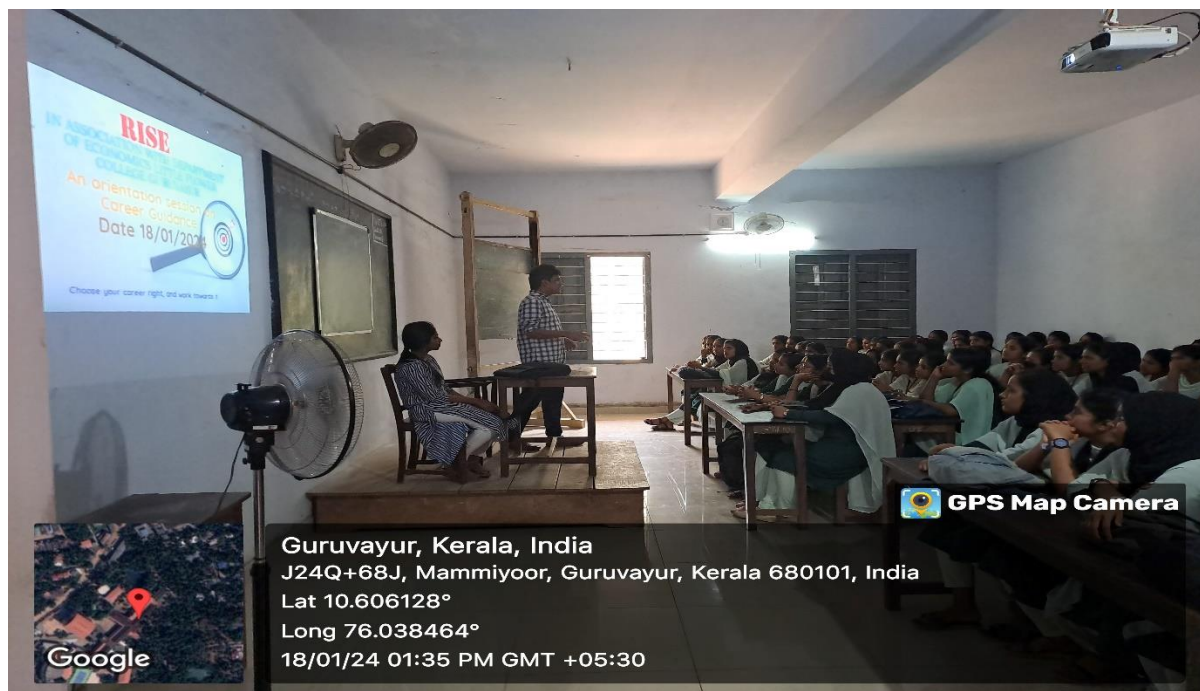
The department of Economics celebrated their Christmas with the Differently abled persons. It was a wonderful experience filled with joy and inclusivity.
