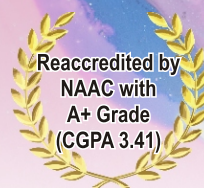

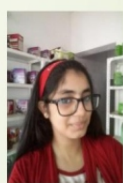

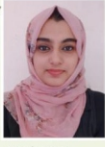

Biological membranes constitute an integral component of cell. They compartmentalize cells and subcellular organelles. In addition, these elegant structures are not only the passive boundaries of life and death, rather the key regulators of the flow of nutrients and metabolites. However, purification of pure membranes is expensive, time-consuming and requires special instrumentation facilities. Hence, model membranes (liposomes) are an alternative procedure to obtain lipid membranes that simulates a biological membrane.

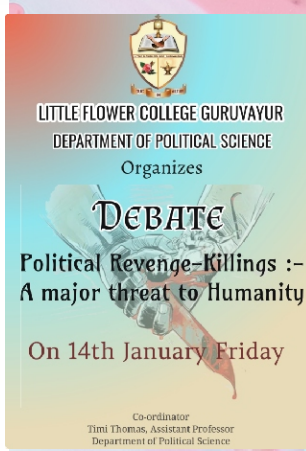

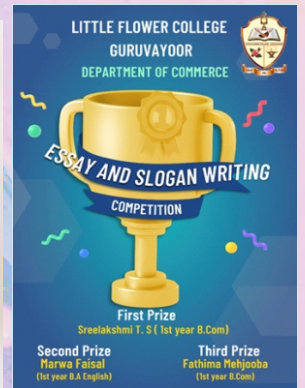
