

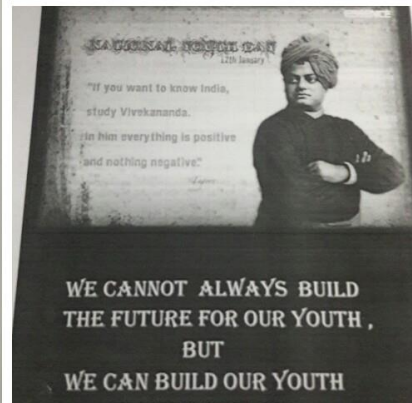
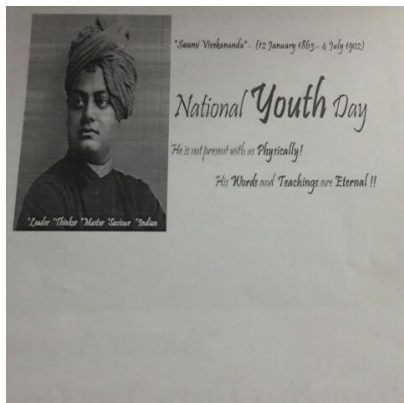
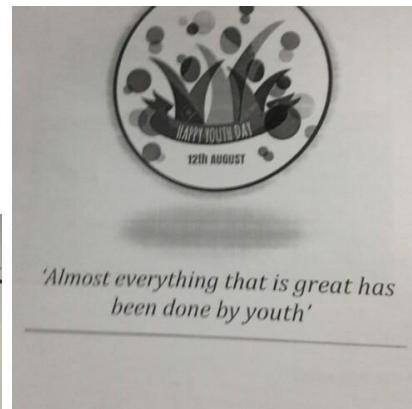
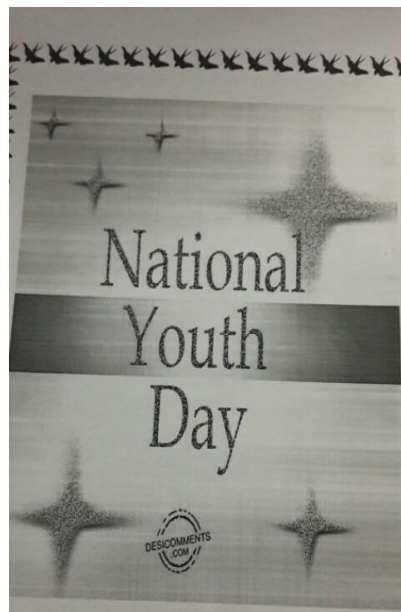
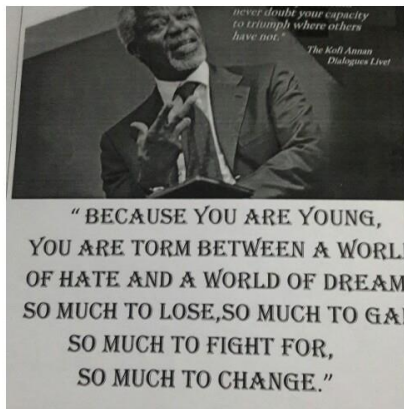
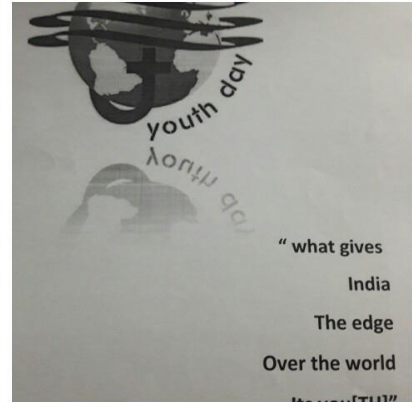
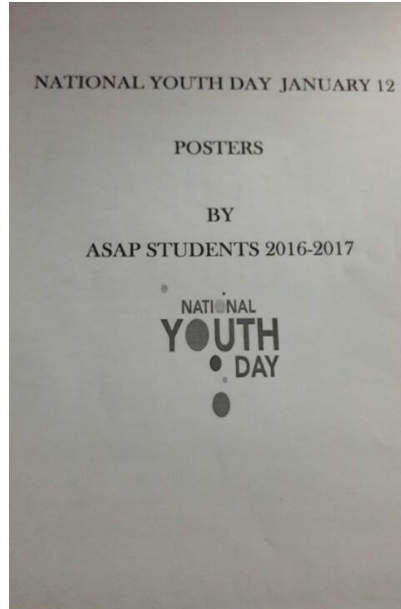
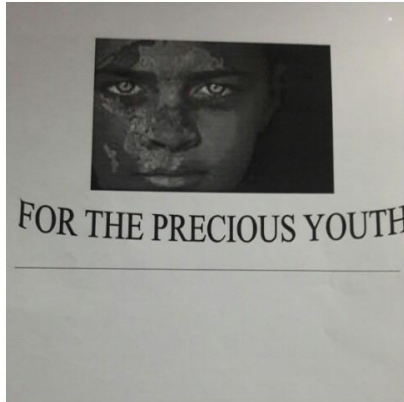
ASAP REPORT
