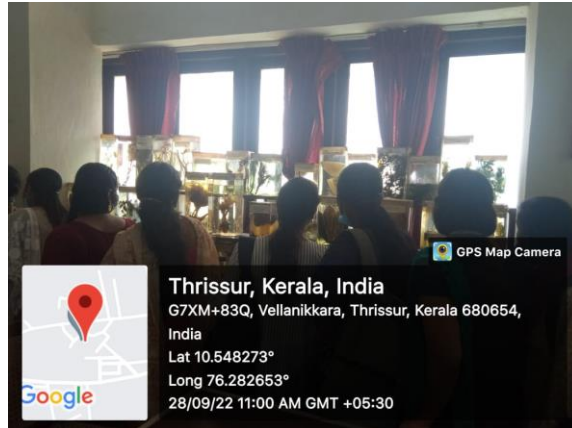

In connection with Pollution Control Day Department of Botany organized an interdepartmental elocution competition for the students of Little Flower College, Guruvayur

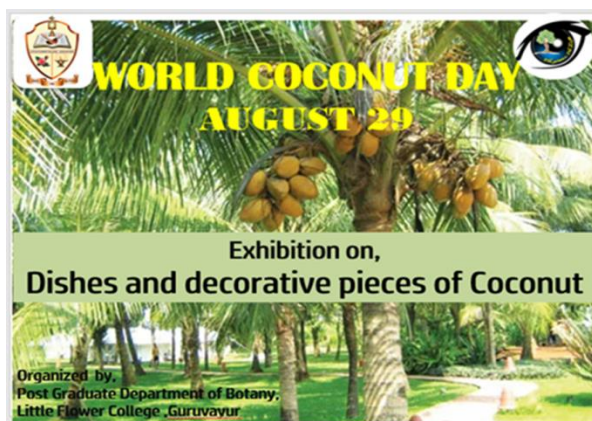
