SCRIPT WRITING WORKSHOP BY MULTIMEDIA

On 6th June 2017 the Dept. of Multimedia has Conducted a script writing workshop and introduced script writing soft wares. Mr. Babu Pallasser , Mollywood Film Maker led the classes for the students. Around 70 students have attended the session.

TRAINING SESSION ON INTRODUCTION TO COMPUTER

Little Flower College, Guruvayoor conducted a training programme on the topic, '*Introduction to Computer*', in compliance with the Government of Kerala's Scholar Support Programme on the 17th of December, 2018. Forty students from the college have attended this course lead by Mr. Jestin James. The aim of this training course was to enhance the soft skills of the students and to build their capacity.

TRAINING SESSION ON INTRANET, SEARCH ENGINE AND EMAILS

On December 11, 2018, forty students of Little Flower College, Guruvayoor, attended a session on the topic, '*Intranet, Search Engines and Emails*' headed by Mr. Jestin James. The session, conducted in collaboration with the Kerala Government's Scholar Support Programme, aimed at enabling the students to improve their ICT skills expand their capacity.

TRAINING SESSION ON WORD PROCESSING AND EXCEL

The Scholar Support Programme, a venture of the Kerala Government and Little Flower College, Guruvayoor jointly conducted a one-day training session on December 15, 2018, titled, '*Word Processing and Excel*', lead by Mr. Jestin James. A total of forty students have attended this session that strove to improve the mental capacity of the students while enhancing their ICT skills.

TRAINING SESSION ON EXCEL AND POWERPOINT

A training course for students on the topic, '*Excel and PowerPoint*', was conducted by Little Flower College, Guruvayoor in accordance with the norms set by the Scholar Support Programme (a Kerala Government initiative) on the 18th of December, 2018 with the aim of improving the ICT capabilities and capacity of the students. Forty students attended this course headed by Mr. Jestin James.

TRAINING SESSIONS ON POWERPOINT AND TYPES OF DATABASES

January 1, 2019, saw forty students attend a crash course on '*PowerPoint and the Types of Databases*', hosted by the joint initiative of Little Flower College, Guruvayoor and the Scholar Support Programme of the Government Kerala. The course was taught by Mr. Jestin James. The course proved helpful to developing the technological skills of the students.

TRAINING SESSION ON MS ACCESS

Recognizing the need to equip the students with new and improved skill sets to enable them to compete in a level ground for their future opportunities, Little Flower College, Guruvayoor with the support of the Government of Kerala venture, The Scholar Support Programme, conducted a training course, '*MS Access*', on January 22, 2019. The course was lead by Mr. Jestin James.

TRAINING SESSION ON MS ACCESS

A crash course on '*MS Access*' was conducted as a joint effort of Little Flower College, Guruvayoor and the Scholar Support Programme (a Government of Kerala initiative) taught by Mr. Jestin James on the 9th of February, 2019. This class saw a total of forty students participating in it. The objective achieved by this class was to familiarize the students with Access and improve their abilities to use it more effectively.

TRAINING SESSION ON BASICS OF IMAGE EDITING

Forty students participated in a training class titled, '*The Basics of Image Editing*', headed by Mr. Jestin James on February 19, 2019. This class was the result of a collaboration of Little Flower College, Guruvayoor and the Government of Kerala's Scholar Support Programme that aimed at providing the students with a better understanding of image editing.

LIBREOFFICE SUIT WRITER TRAINING

In partnership with Spoken Tutorial Project ,IIT Bombay, '*LibreOffice Suite Writer Training*' was organized in the Little Flower College campus in July 2017. Twenty four students from the college have enrolled and successfully completed the training.
