POSTER MAKING COMPETITION IN CONNECTION WITH WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY




A BOOK REVIEW WRITING CONTEST IN CONNECTION WITH READING WEEK


ONLINE BOOK READING COMPETITION



INTERCOLLEGIATE ELOCUTION COMPETITION IN CONNECTION WITH INDEPENDENCE DAY


12th -16th August 2021


DRAWING COMPETITION IN CONNECTION WITH INDEPENDENCE DAY


ESSAY WRITING CONTEST IN CONNECTION WITH GANDHI JAYANTHI
