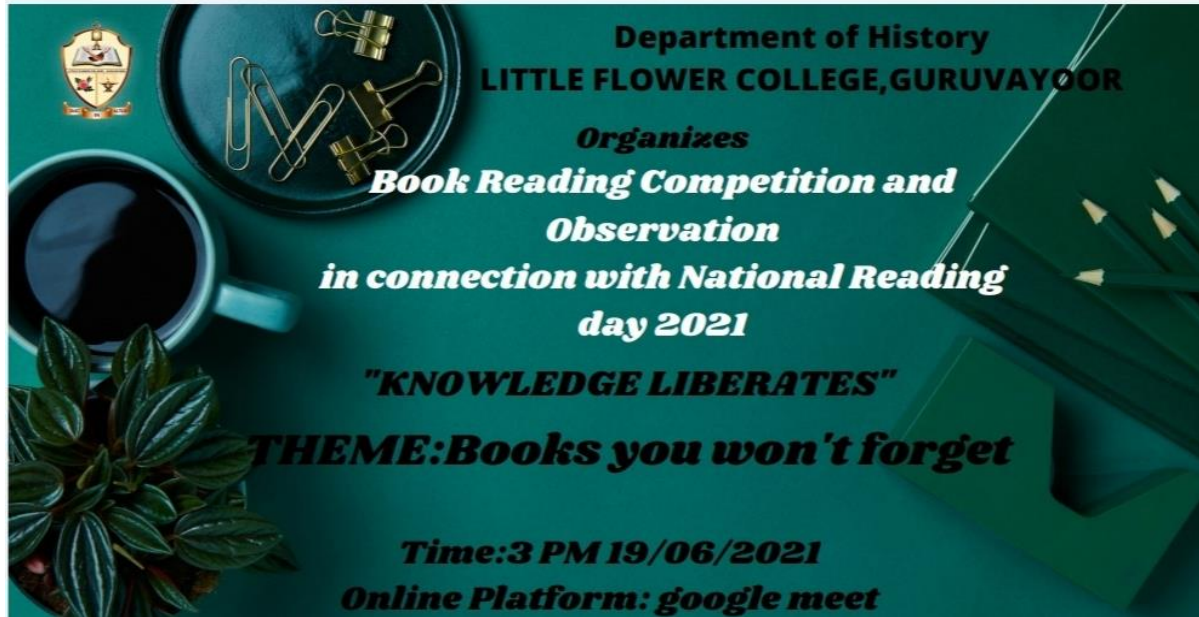

## **ONLINE BOOK READING COMPETITION**

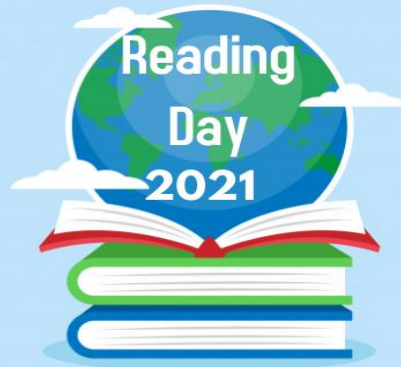

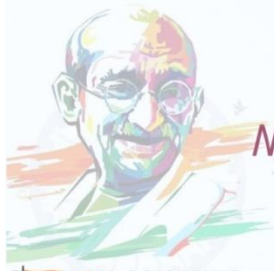
**ONLINE QUIZ COMPETITION ON NATIONAL MOVEMENT 1915-1947

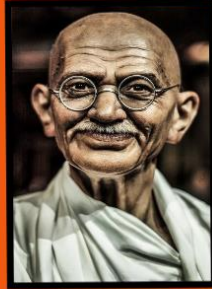
**ESSAY WRITING CONTEST IN CONNECTION WITH GANDHI JAYANTHI**
